

Bibliographies about Individual Persons H 1322

1. General rule. Use the free-floating form subdivision **-Bibliography** under names of individuals for lists of works by or about those persons.

For lists of musical works by a person that include musical notation for the opening measures of individual works or sections of works, use the free-floating form subdivision **-Thematic catalogs**.

2. Special topics. If the bibliography has a topical orientation, assign an additional heading of the type [*topic*]-**Bibliography** to bring out the topic. *Example:*

650 #0 $a Psychoanalysis $v Bibliography.
```
